



The Camas post office is a one-story building with a full basement. This is a concrete, wood and brick structure, which during the cold war era doubled as a fallout shelter. A gable roof topped with a square wooden cupola covers the front portion of the building. Wrought-iron balustrades with integrated lamp standards flank the stairs. The entry has double wooden doors each with a molded wooden panel.

The Camas Main Post Office is significant for its art and its legacy of the Federal Public works programs of the depression era and is listed on the National Historic Registry. Visit property website at **www.cbre.com/camasusps**.




HISTORIC POST OFFICE DOWNTOWN CAMAS

The post office building is located in the heart of Camas, WA, ten minutes from Vancouver, WA. Today Camas is building on its smalltown charm, historic downtown and proximity to both Portland and Vancouver to redefine its role.
